Alexandra Montagnese Creator/Performer

Alexandra is a Toronto-based puppeteer, and theatre creator. She has worked with the Shaw Festival, Theatre Rusticle, Watermark Theatre, Thousand Islands Playhouse, WeeFestival, Theatre Direct, Shadowland, Infinitheatre, and SummerWorks to name a few. She is a founding member of Jot & Tittle Puppetry, and is a core member of Lucid Ludic who produced

her one-woman show *Public Mischief*. With a small group of puppet enthusiasts, Alex started Toronto's seasonal puppet and performing objects event *Concrete Cabaret*. She recently won her first Dora award for her Direction of *Moby: a Whale of a Tale* on a pirate ship in Toronto Harbour.



Kristine White Creator/Performer

Kristine is a multidisciplinary artist. She collaborates with other artists, dancers, actors, and musicians to tell stories and create new worlds. As an artist, Kristine has worked for several Toronto-based theatre companies designing puppets, props, and costumes, as well as having produced several of her own shows and installations locally and abroad.

She has also created custom music videos using shadow puppetry and paper-cut animation. Kristine has been awarded several Canada Council, Ontario Arts Council, and Toronto Arts Council grants to support her visual and performance arts projects.
