

We do this through a boundless sense of play and wonder, a myriad of inspirations and collaborators, and multiple access points for audiences to enjoy. We are a Torontobased, artist-run company with strong partnerships with artists and organizations across Ontario and Canada. Common Boots has been honoured with 10 Dora Mayor Moore Awards and 54 nominations; and the Chalmers Best Canadian Play Award, for The Betrayal, as well as nominations for Dr. Dapertutto and The Attic, the Pearls & Three Fine Girls.
